



2026 ASANA World Series Field Complex Rules

1. General Complex Rules

The following restrictions apply throughout the entire complex, including on the fields of play where applicable. For full detail, links to local ordinances referenced and city municipal codes:

- No persons or property may remain in the park while the park is closed. TCC 21-2b and TCC 21-3 (7)(3)
- No camping. TCC 21-3(5)
- Park in designated parking lots only. No motorized vehicles on park grounds. TCC 21-3 (4)(3)
- No overnight parking, camping, or storing of personal items. TCC 21-3(5)(4)
- Do not construct or erect any building or structure of whatever kind, whether permanent or temporary in character, or run or string any public service utility into, upon or across park land. TCC 21-3(1)
- No glass containers. TCC 21-3 (3)(3)
- Dispose of litter properly in receptacles where provided.
- No disposing of residential or commercial trash on park grounds or in park containers.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times. TCC 4-97 Clean up pet waste. TCC 4-102 TCC 21-3(7)(b)
- No hitting golf balls, hunting, target shooting, or archery. TCC 21-3 (5)(5)
- Use skateboards, roller skates, and rollerblades in designated areas only. TCC 20-28 (B)
- Fires are allowed in grills only. Leave ash in grills for disposal by park staff. Gas/propane grills are prohibited.
- Respect the area wildlife. Do not feed wildlife.
- No drones or remote control aircraft except at the designated area in Danny Lopez Park.
- No Model rockets or fireworks.
- No destruction of, damage to, or removal of City property.
- Special Events, metal detecting, amusement equipment (e.g., jumping castles, kiddie trains, pony rides), amplified music, food distribution, and beer/wine drinking and commercial vending are allowed by permit only and may not be permissible in all parks.
- No vending without a Park Department-issued permit. TCC 21-3(6)
- Included advertising and signs
- Contact (520) 791-4873 for more information and to obtain permits.
- Exceptions may be granted for certain activities associated with Special Events.
- Park only in designated areas within the parking lots. Vehicles parked on the grass and/or curbsides are subject to ticketing or towing
- No metal spikes. Players will be ejected from the game and can't return until they're wearing molded or turf cleats.
- All menstrual products must be properly disposed of and not flushed in toilets.
- The complex will close 60 minutes after the last game ends, unless otherwise communicated by facility staff or ASANA leadership.

2. Entry to the Complex

- Access to the complex is permitted only through designated and clearly marked points of entry. Complex staff may or may not be present at these locations. Upon request, all individuals entering the complex are required to submit bags, coolers, and similar items for inspection.
- Wristbands are not required for entry but are encouraged as a visible identifier of event participants and supporters.

3. Security

- Security cameras may be present throughout the complex, and activities may be subject to video recording for general facility operations.
- All participants must follow all directions and instructions given by individuals identified as security, complex facility staff, and the ASANA Board.

4. Food and Beverage

- No restrictions on outside food, water, ice, or coolers.
- No alcoholic beverages can be brought onto the complex grounds, including the parking lot. Consumption of alcoholic beverages in the parking lot is strictly prohibited. Anyone in violation of this rule will be asked to leave the facility.

5. Safety and Weather

- In the event of inclement weather, everyone in the complex will be notified by the sounding of an air horn or verbally by Tournament Operations and Umpires. We will only make this notification when we have been made aware of a serious weather event approaching the park.
- Immediately upon notification, all individuals must evacuate the complex and seek shelter in a vehicle in the parking lot. In the event of severe weather or other emergencies, all exits will be available and should be used. Follow the directions of complex staff to access the nearest exit.
- All communications on weather and schedule updates will be published electronically via official ASANA channels (e.g.: Tourney Machine app, ASANA Social Media Accounts, etc).
